Current situation

- Current environmental legislation on water is adequate.
 - Challenge: full implementation
- Current environmental legislation on biodiversity is targeted to NATURA.
 - Biodiversity strategy: key to delivery of broader aims.
 - -> CAP will be central to success in EU.
- The absence of legislation on soil is a serious missed opportunity
 - Without legislation: slow progress on protection.

We seek broader cross-compliance including water framework directive and water management issues.



ENV priorities for agriculture and forestry

- Full acceptance and implementation of NATURA 2000.
- Boost to protection of permanent pasture for climate, water and biodiversity reasons.
- Strengthening high nature value areas so helping biodiversity and socio-economic role of agriculture.
- Greater recognition of biodiversity through biodiversity corridors and set-aside with additional links to water protection.

Strengthening role of Pillar I in environmental delivery

Further strengthening rural development to ensure delivery of environmental public goods.
